Biosecurity panels for the horse stalls will be available to rent, and will include heavy zip ties to attach to the horse stall panel. This will provide a safe, clean and comfortable environment to house your dairy goats during this event.

The Wisconsin Host Group and all who are working on this premier event are excited about meeting ADGA members from around the country, and we look forward to seeing many of you at the National Show this July.
