Artificial Insemination Buck Collection Report

BUCKS collected June 1, 2016 or later must have DNA on file in order to register offspring from that collection.

The Artificial Insemination Buck Collection form is required for all bucks collected January 1, 1991, or later, and should be sent to ADGA within ten (10) days from the date of each collection. No fee is required. Offspring resulting from the use of such semen will not be registered if this form is not on file with ADGA.

The original registration certificate, a photocopy of the registration certificate or an officially stamped duplicate application must be presented for tattoo verification to the processor or the person reading the buck's tattoo.

The owner and processor/or person appointed by the processor must read the tattoo on the buck to ensure that the animal being collected is properly identified. The processor or appointed person reading the tattoo must sign below, verifying that they have read the buck's tattoo and that the tattoo corresponds with the tattoo listed on the registration paper.

It is recommended that the owner of the buck file the collection report with ADGA. However, the form will be accepted from either the processor or owner. Information provided on this form is confidential to the owner, processor, and the American Dairy Goat Association.
