Hello DIII members. I am running for a seat on the ADGA BOD. I am currently a life member and have judged for 20+ years. I currently have a few animals Nigerian, Alpine, and LaMancha. Previously I served one term on the BOD. My background in Nursing is mostly ICU where situations must be assessed quickly and fixed ASAP. I also was a nursing supervisor both in a hospital and a large institution for the mentally handicapped.
