Scholarship Criteria:

- 1. Applicant holds an Individual Regular ADGA membership and is at least 18 years of age.
- 2. Applicant is a new candidate or a first-time renewing candidate for an ADGA judge's license.
- 3. This cover sheet is to be included with the following documents:
 - a. Applicant must submit an essay of no more than one thousand words detailing experience with dairy goats and personal reasons for wishing to become an ADGA licensed judge.
 - b. Applicant must contact no more than three persons to submit letters of reference about the person applying. Such persons could be ADGA judges, directors, or reputable breeders, youth project leaders and/or vocational agriculture instructors.
